At an adjourned business meeting of the Livermore Public Library Association, held last evening, the following resolution was offered, action upon which will be taken at the next regular monthly business meeting, to be held on the evening of the first Tuesday of October:

Resolved, That Article VI of this Constitution be and is hereby amended to read as follows:

Any person can become a life member of the Livermore Public Library Association by signing the Constitution and by-laws, and paying to the secretary the sum of three dollars. Persons who became members previous to January 1st, 1881, and have paid dues to that date, and all members who shall pay said back dues to said date, or the sum of three dollars, on or before the first Tuesday of November, 1881, are hereby declared life members. Persons becoming life members are entitled to certificate of life membership, which shall entitle said member and family to all the privileges of said Association, during the term of his or her natural life.
